

Helping Children Stay in School

Children Sponsorship Impact Report

Empower for More Initiative provided educational support to selected pupils of St Patrick's Caring Heart Mega Primary School, helping to reduce school-related financial barriers and support continued learning.

The sponsorship focused on practical needs that directly affect school participation and academic progress. A total of **₺300,500** was paid directly to the school to cover uniforms, sandals, and Common Entrance fees for selected pupils.

Impact Created

This intervention helped pupils meet important school requirements that could have affected their participation in learning and examination access.

For pupils supported with uniforms and sandals, the sponsorship helped improve school readiness, comfort, and participation. For pupils whose Common Entrance fees were covered, the support helped remove a financial barrier to an important academic transition.

The payment was made directly to the school, strengthening transparency and helping ensure that the support reached the intended educational needs.

Key Outcomes

- 9 pupils received school uniform support.
- 8 pupils received school sandal support.
- 16 pupils had their Common Entrance fees covered.
- **₺300,500** was paid directly to the school.
- The intervention supported school participation, examination access, and family relief.

Why This Matters

For many families, school-related expenses can become barriers to a child's learning journey. A uniform, a pair of sandals, or an examination fee may seem small, but for a child in need, it can determine whether they are prepared, included, and able to move forward.
